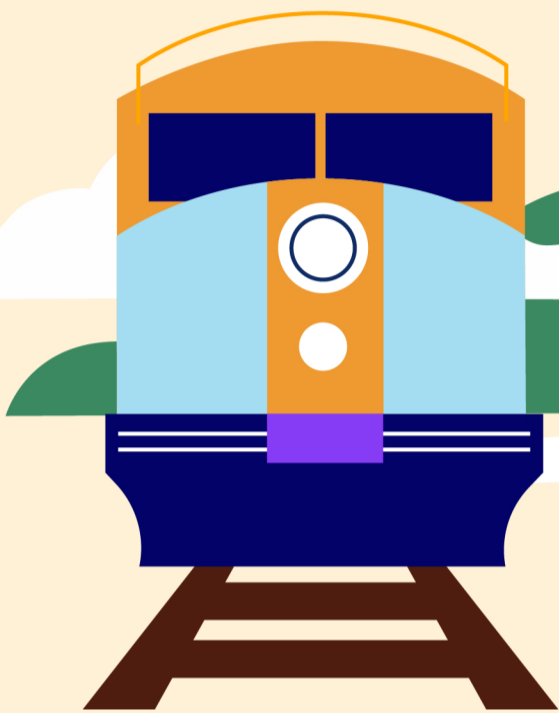


TOP MUSEUMS

GALVESTON RAILROAD MUSEUM

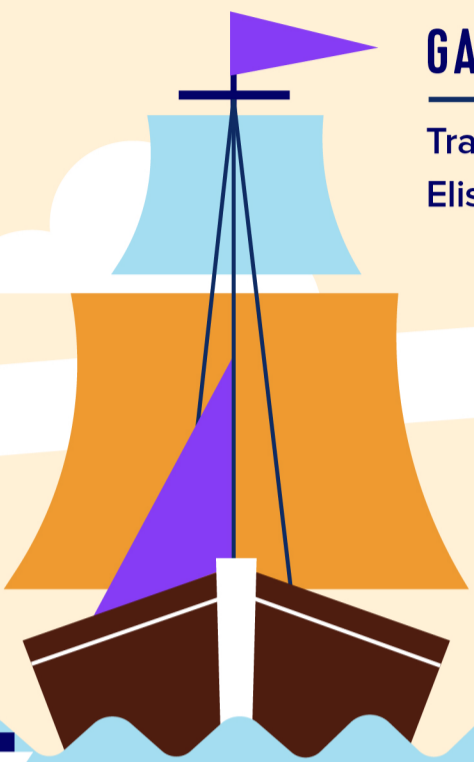
Learn about America's golden age of rail travel.

Discover one of Texas' best contemporary art collections.



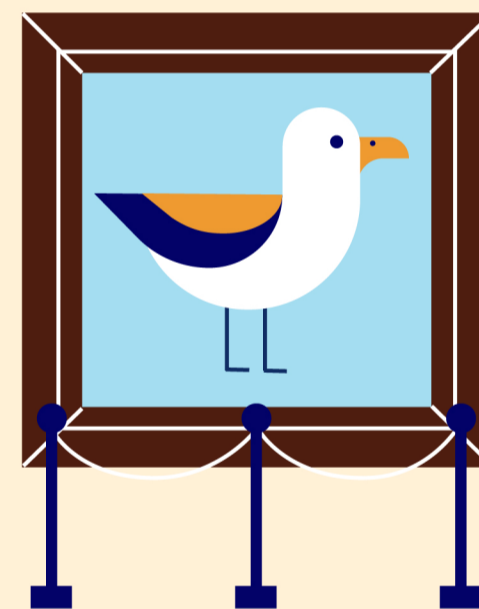
GALVESTON HISTORIC SEAPORT

Travel back in time as you tour the tall ship Elissa, a three-masted barque built in 1877.

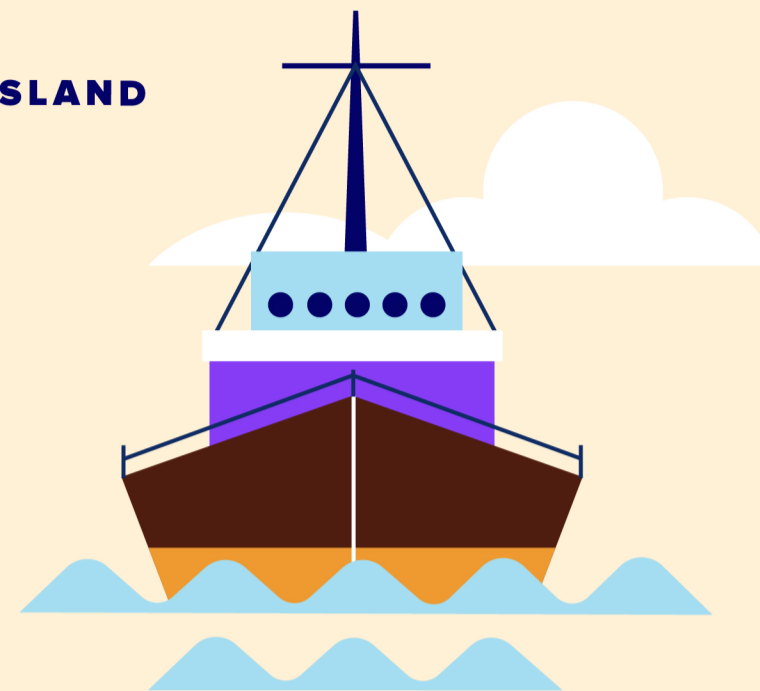
HARBORSIDE DR

15TH STREET



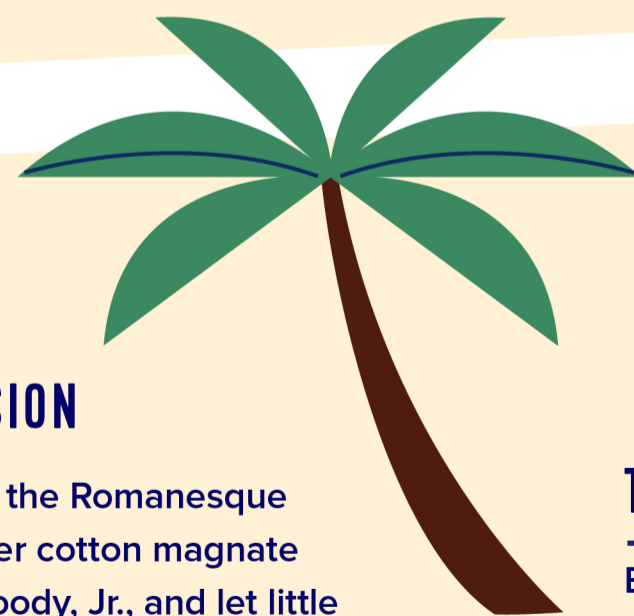
BISHOP'S PALACE
